1. Heard learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Petitioners are not the principal accused who had assaulted the victim with *hasua* causing grievous injury.
3. Keeping in mind the extent of complicity of the petitioners in the crime, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to them.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners viz., **(1) Jakir Hossain, (2) Md Obaidur Rahaman, (3) Erfan Mia @ Irfan Mia, (4) Lalbanu Bibi @ Lalbanu, and (5) Doly Bibi @ Dali Khatun** be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. They shall appear before the

jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
