In re : An Application for **cancellation** of bail under Section 14-A of the Scheduled Casts and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 read with Section 439(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, in connection with Raina Police Station Case No.379 of 2023 dated 17.08.2023 under Sections 363/365/34 of the Indian Penal Code added Sections 368/370 of the Indian Penal Code read with Sections 3(2)V of the Schedules Casts & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

1. Report submitted in Court be taken on record.
2. Petitioner prays for cancellation of bail granted by the learned Special Judge on January 9, 2024.
3. Statutory bail was granted to the private opposite parties.
4. Victim is yet to be recovered.
5. Pursuant to the order passed by the High Court, investigation was made over to the Central Bureau of Investigation (C.B.I.).
6. There is hardly any material change in circumstances subsequent to the C.B.I. taking over investigation.
7. Charge sheet is yet to be filed.
8. There is no allegation of post bail misconduct.

9. In such circumstances, we find no ground to interfere with the order granting bail to the private opposite parties.
