Having heard the learned advocates representing the parties and upon perusal of the averments made in the application explaining the delay, I am satisfied that sufficient cause existed which prevented the petitioner from preferring the application being WPA 1204 of 2022 within the period of limitation provided therefor.

Accordingly, application for condonation is allowed.
Delay is condoned.

In Re : CAN 1 of 2025

This is an application for substitution. As noted earlier, during pendency of the proceedings the
