1. Heard learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Petitioner has deposited 50% of the of the provisional assessment bill for unmetered consumption to the tune of Rs.4,46,968/-.
3. In light of the aforesaid fact and nature of offence, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner viz., **Biswajit Maity** be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. He shall appear

before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
