1. Let affidavit-of-service as filed in Court be kept on record.
2. The petitioner, a successful tenderer, under the WBSRDA (respondent no. 4 herein), has completed the work given to him under a tender. Upon completion of the work, payment has been made and duly received by the petitioner.
3. The petitioner claims the differential amount, that has arisen upon promulgation of the GST, sometime in the year, 2017. For such purpose, the petitioner had also made a representation on 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 2023 which is yet to be considered.
4. Respondent no. 4 is directed to consider such representation within a period of three weeks from date, positively by November 30, 2025, upon given a hearing to the petitioner and a reasoned order be passed on the representation within a period of

two weeks thereafter which shall be duly communicated to the petitioner.

5. The instant writ petition is, thus, disposed of with the aforestated directions.

6. There shall, however, be no order as to costs.
