The petitioner has applied for license of FPS in terms of vacancy notification ID 20220024415. It appears that after filing of application, the proposed shop-cum-godown was inspected, but since then the authority concerned has not taken any decision.

It appears that the petitioner has filed a representation to the authority. It was also not considered. It further appears that license was not issued in favour of anyone till today.

Thus, the writ petition appears to be a premature one. Hence, this writ petition stands dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to sue afresh on the self-same cause of action.
