1. By an order dated February 21, 2025, the petitioner was granted *interim* bail.
2. We are told that as of date, three out of 11 charge-sheet named witnesses have been examined. Therefore, we do not see the possibility of an early conclusion of the trial.
3. The State files a report. We see that there is nothing adverse against the petitioner. The petitioner has been complying with the conditions of *interim* bail.
4. In that view of the matter, we are inclined to confirm the order of *interim* bail that the petitioner is enjoying on the same terms and conditions on which *interim* bail was granted and we do so.
5. Accordingly, the application for bail being CRM (NDPS) 148 of 2025 is disposed of by confirming the *interim* bail on the same terms and conditions.
