1. Heard learned lawyers for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Petitioner contends there is a land dispute between the parties. Injury report discloses simple injury. Hence, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
3. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under section 482(2) of BNSS 2023.
4. Petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.
5. The application being CRM (A) 351 of 2025 is disposed of.
