1. Heard learned lawyers for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Petitioners contend there is a land dispute and free fight ensued between the parties. Injury report does not disclose grievous injury. Hence, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
3. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under section 482(2) of BNSS 2023.
4. Petitioners shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.
5. The application being CRM (A) 352 of 2025 is disposed of.
