**C.R.M. (DB) 500 of 2025**

Petitioner seeks parity with the co-accused standing on the same footing who have been granted bail earlier.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer.

It appears that the petitioner is similarly circumstanced with the other co-accused who have been granted bail earlier. The petitioner is in custody for about six months. His further detention is not required and he may be granted bail subject to stringent conditions.

Accordingly the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Berhampur, Murshidabad subject to condition that he shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate

witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event the petitioner fails to appear before the learned trial court without any justifiable cause, the learned trial court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

The application for bail, being CRM (DB) 500 of 2025, is, thus, disposed of.
