1. Report by the Secretary of Malda Zilla Regulated Market Committee signed on February 19, 2025 has already been furnished in WPA No.3195 of 2025. The same is also applicable in this case.
2. A report of the Sub-Divisional Officer, Chanchal Malda signed on February 24, 2025 be retained with the records.
3. It appears therefrom that none of the aforesaid authorities is taking any coercive step against the petitioners, as on date.
4. According to the Regulated Market Committee, the subject land is vested to the State and the Committee will take steps, in accordance with law, for removal of the unauthorized occupants.
5. It appears that there is no imminent threat of either dispossession or demolition of the construction of the petitioners.
6. It will be open for all the parties to avail necessary remedies as available in law.
