In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita in connection with Pursurah Police Station Case No. 322 of 2024 dated 08.11.2024 under Sections 115(2)/117(2)/118(2)/119(1)/76/109/127(4)/131(4)(5)(6)(7)(8)/229(3)(4)/351(2)/303/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.

1. Heard the learned advocates for the parties.

2. We have considered the materials on record. There is a civil dispute between the parties. Injury report shows simple injury. Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

3. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and on condition that they shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within a period of four weeks from date.

4. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
