1. Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits they are relations of the deceased. Out of depression he had consumed sleeping pills and committed suicide. They pray for anticipatory bail.

2. Learned Counsel for the State opposes the prayers for anticipatory bail.

3. We have considered the materials on record including the exonerative statement of the victim's son. No suicide note implicating the petitioners is placed on record. Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the

satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and on condition that they shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within a period of four weeks from date.

5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
