1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. It is contended incident occurred in course of a sudden quarrel between the couple. Injuries are simple and the act does not appear to be a pre-meditated one.
3. Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner viz., **Aniruddha Chowdhury** be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS. He shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.
5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
