The petitioner is aggrieved by the fact that the property which has been inherited by him has been sold away by the private respondents by forging the original documents. To that effect, the petitioner lodged a complaint with the Hatishala Police Station.

Mr. Bandopadhyay, Id. Senior Standing Counsel, appearing for the State submits a report which reflects that Hatishala P.S. Case No. 34 dated 20.02.2025 has been registered for investigation under the relevant provisions

of BNS.

In view of the police authorities having taken steps on the complaint/information furnished by the petitioner, I am of the view that, for the present, further pendency of the writ petition is unwarranted.

However, the police authorities would put in efforts and take effective steps for unearthing the truth before arriving at their conclusion within a reasonable period of time.

With the aforesaid observations, WPA 3598 of 2025 is disposed of.
