Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been subjected to harassment and has not been allowed by the private respondents to enjoy her property.

State has submitted a report which reflects that a civil suit being T.S. 111 of 2013 is pending between the petitioner and the private respondents before the learned jurisdictional Court.

Having considered the nature of the dispute complained of, I direct that if the petitioner has any grievance, the petitioner would be at liberty to approach

the jurisdictional Civil Court already *in seisin* of the matter and, if any necessary direction(s) is passed upon the police authorities for rendering assistance, the police authorities would then take steps in accordance with law.

With the aforesaid observations, WPA 3617 of 2025 is disposed of.

Pending application(s), if any, is also disposed of.
