Learned advocate for the petitioners is aggrieved by the fact that the representation which was addressed to the Officer-in-charge of Nandakumar Police Station on or about 23.12.2022 did not yield any result.

Learned advocate for the private respondents submits that the petitioners and the private respondents have contested a long drawn civil proceeding. Learned advocate also submits that a revisional application is pending before this Hon'ble Court.

Learned advocate for the State submits that the nature of the dispute complained of is absolutely a civil dispute, the police authorities will not be able to act until and unless there are directions from a court of law.

Be that as it may, since the representation which was made is of 23.12.2022, I am of the view that if same inconveniences are faced by the petitioners, a fresh representation be submitted before the authorities concerned and the police authorities would act in accordance with law.

With the aforesaid observations, WPA 3603 of 2023 is disposed of.
