Petitioner is aggrieved by the act and action of the police authorities and submits that inspite of submitting all the documents with the police no action has been taken.

State has submitted a report. Report is enclosed with order dated 09.01.2025, wherein the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Purba Bardhaman in an application under Section 175(3) of the BNSS was pleased after considering the enquiry report to reject the same.

Since the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Purba Bardhaman has already interfered and passed a direction, I am of the view that the present writ petition is not maintainable. Petitioner would, if so advised approach the Revisional Court if he is aggrieved by the order dated 09.01.2025.
