By this application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for a direction upon the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), 3<sup>rd</sup> Court at Tamluk, Purba Medinipur to dispose of the J. Misc. Case No.4 of 2014.

It appears from the orders appended to the civil revisional application that 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2025 has been fixed for evidence of PW 2.

In view of the order sought and proposed to be passed, there is no necessity to direct issuance of notice upon the opposite parties. However, the petitioner shall be obliged to forward the copy of this application as well as the order of this court upon the opposite parties and the learned advocate appearing for the opposite parties in the learned trial court.
