It is submitted by the petitioner that the last date of the examination by which the petitioner acquired the graduation degree on 25th September, 2017 is 4th September, 2016. Even if the last date of the examination by which the petitioner became a graduate is taken into account to be the date on which the petitioner acquired the graduation degree then also the petitioner does not fulfill the three years experience after acquiring the graduation degree.

The petitioner, therefore, does not fulfill the requisite criteria under the advertisement. The

petitioner is, therefore, disqualified on that ground alone.

The writ petition, therefore, is unmeritorious and is accordingly **dismissed**.

There will no order as to costs.
