1. This is an application with a prayer for early disposal of all interlocutory applications, particularly, under Section 7(2) of the West Bengal Premises Tenancy Act as well as the application under Order XXXIX Rule 7 of the Code of Civil Procedure.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has tried to make this Court understand that these applications were fixed for hearing.
