1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Injury report shows injuries are simple and on non vital parts of the body. No bomb blast injury is noted in the medical papers.
3. Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner viz., **Tara Ghosh** be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS. He shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.
5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
