1. Heard the learned advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Co-accused have been granted anticipatory bail. Petitioners stand on the same footing with the said co-accused. Hence, they are entitled to similar relief.
3. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and on further condition that the

petitioners shall meet the investigating officer once in a week until further orders. They shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within a period of four weeks from date.

4. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
