Sessions Judge, 3rd Court, Asansol;, Paschim Bardhaman.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the State produced a report and the same is taken on record.

Learned Counsel for the State raised objection contending that 20.414 kgs. of Ganja was recovered from the exclusive possession of the present petitioner and charge has already been framed and it is expected that within a short span of time the trial would be concluded.

He further submits that out of ten charge sheeted witnesses they have proposed to examine only five witnesses.

Having heard learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and the State and also considering the fact that the rigor of Section 37 of the NDPS Act attracts in the present case, the prayer for bail is rejected. However, I am informed that the charge has already been framed and as such the Trial Court is requested to conclude the trial preferably within eight months from the next date of hearing.

CRM (NDPS) No. 251 2025 thus stands disposed of.
