1. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to correct the cause title.
2. Heard the learned advocates for the parties.
3. We have considered the materials on record. Co-accused, Rajat Mondal has been granted anticipatory bail by the learned Sessions Judge. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya

Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and on condition that he shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within a period of four weeks from date.

5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
