Status report submitted by the State is taken on record.

The petitioner is in custody for more than two years and prays for bail.

Opposing the prayer learned counsel for the State submits that only the Investigating Officer is left to be examined and trial is about to conclude.

On merits, the bail prayer of the petitioner was turned down by this Court earlier. There is no change of circumstances which warrants a favourable order at this stage. Accordingly prayer for bail is rejected at this stage.
