This is an application wherein the petitioner has prayed for expeditious disposal of the G.R. case no. 242 of 2023, presently pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate, 2nd Court, Barasat under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, it appears that the prayer made by the petitioner is innocuous and if it is allowed, the opposite parties will have no cause to prejudice and therefore the service of copy of application upon the opposite parties is hereby dispensed with.
