1. The petitioner has filed the present application being CAN 1 of 2025 praying for recalling of the order dated 18th September, 2025 wherein, this Court has dismissed the writ application for default for non-appearance of the petitioner at the time of call.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter was listed in the combined monthly list on 18th September, 2025 but on the said date monthly list has been collapsed early due to which the petitioner could not appear before this Court.
