In the circumstances, the D.P.S.C., Birbhum shall obtain the medical opinion of the petitioner's son from the CMOH, Birbhum and forward the same along with comments to the Secretary, WBBPE. Upon receipt of the medical opinion of the petitioner's son and if satisfied, the Secretary, WBBPE shall take an appropriate decision thereon, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of communication of a copy of this order.

With the above observations and directions this writ petition being WPA 4915 of 2025 stands disposed of.

However, there shall be no order as to costs.
