4. In the event, the grievances are filed before the appropriate committee along with copy of this order within the aforesaid time, the said committee shall endeavour to decide the grievances by passing a reasoned and

speaking order in accordance with law preferably within 90 days therefrom.

5. The outcome shall be communicated to the petitioners.
6. These PILs are disposed of without expressing any opinion on the merits of these cases.
