The petitioner approached this Court expressing his agony since his daughter was missing.

State has submitted a report which reflects that the petitioner along with his daughter appeared before the concerned police station and prayed for withdrawal of the missing diary. Having regard to the fact that the girl/daughter of the petitioner has returned

and they have no further grievance so far as the police authorities are considered, I am of the view that further pendency of the writ petition is unwarranted.
