1. Report filed by the State, affidavit-in-opposition filed by the respondent no.8 and affidavit-in-reply filed by the petitioner are taken on record.

Mr. Ratul Biswas, learned Advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the Sub-Divisional Officer, Bishnupur, respondent no.4 during the pendency of the writ petition has passed an order of demolition on 1st September, 2025, which requires to be challenged.
