Affidavit-of-service and acknowledgement for
payment of deficit Court fees filed on behalf of the
petitioners be kept with the record.

The petitioners are the Assistant
Teachers at different schools under District
Primary School Council, Hooghly.

The petitioners have B.Ed. as their
training qualification but since they have not
completed six months Bridge Course from a
recognized institution, they are not getting 'A'
Category Scale of Pay.

Mr. Maji, learned advocate for the
petitioners submits that similarly placed
teachers have been given the benefit of 'A'
Category Scale of Pay.

He prays that the issue may be relegated
to the Commissioner of School Education,
Government of West Bengal, the respondent no.
3 herein, for consideration.

The respondent no. 3 is directed to consider the prayer of the petitioner for 'A' category scale of pay in accordance with law and to facilitate such consideration, the petitioners are directed supply the complete copy of the writ petition to the respondent no. 3.

W.P.A. 5854 of 2025 is disposed of with the above terms without any order as to costs.

Since no affidavit has been invited, the allegations made in the writ petition are deemed to have been denied by the respondents.

Urgent photostat certified copy of this order, if applied for, be supplied to the parties subject to compliance with all requisite formalities.
