Report submitted by the State be kept with the record. The report reflects that the petitioner's representative did not visit the police station, as such, the motor bike/motor cycle bearing Registration No. WB-97B-3441 which was seized in connection with Diamond Harbour G.D.E. No. 1536 dated 20.02.2025 could not be returned.

Mr. Chatterjee, learned advocate for the petitioner, submits that because of other compulsions, the petitioner's representative could not attend the police station.

In view of the admitted position, the police authorities are directed to return the said motor bike/motor cycle to the petitioner and/or his authorized representative(s) if the petitioner and/or his authorized representative approaches the police station with proper documents.

With the aforesaid observations, WPA 6441 of 2025 is disposed of.
