Leave granted to the learned advocate appearing for the petitioners to correct the cause title.

In an incident of assault, one person suffered superficial linear abrasion.

Considering the nature of the injury and as well as the involvement of the petitioner therein, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) B.N.S.S. The petitioners will report before the Investigating Officer once a fortnight till the conclusion of the investigation. The petitioners

shall appear on every date before the Jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
