1. Police filed charge-sheet.
2. An incident of assault took place between two parties where four persons suffered injury in such incident of assault one of whom suffered an injury over the scalp and was administered four stitches.
3. Considering the nature of the incident, the involvement of the petitioners therein and the fact police filed charge-sheet, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners will be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten

Thousand only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the BNSS, and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

5. This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
