*In re : An Application for **Anticipatory Bail** under Section **438** of the Code of Criminal Procedure corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with **Khejuri** Police Station Case No. **561** of **2023** dated **05.09.2023** under Sections **186 / 188 /147 /148 /448 /325/326/332/333/307/379/427** of Indian Penal Code, 1860 read with Section **3** of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act and Section **9** of the Maintenance of Public Order Act and section **9** of the Explosive Substance Act pending before ACJM, Contai, Purba Medinipur.*

1. Petitioner claims to be a Government school teacher. First information report was against unknown persons. At least the petitioner was not named therein.
2. Police filed charge sheet.
3. Possibility of absconsion is not apparent.
4. In such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
5. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and on further condition that the

petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

6. Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.
7. **CRM (A) 1025 of 2025** is **disposed of**.
