This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the plaintiffs praying for a direction upon the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), 6<sup>th</sup> Court at Alipore to dispose of the Ejectment Suit No.220 of 2022 expeditiously.

There will be no order as to costs.
