1. None appears on behalf of the petitioner on call.

No accommodation is sought for. Even on earlier occasions, none appeared on behalf of either of the parties on call.

2. This case pertains to the year 2010, almost 15 years have been elapsed.

3. The petitioner has approached before this court by filing the writ petition praying for a direction upon the Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Hooghly/the respondent no. 3 to grant the temporary permit of the vehicle (Auto Rickshaw) being Registration No. W.B. 15/5399.

4. Considering the nature of prayer and long pendency of this case, this court finds that either the petitioner's purpose of filing writ petition has been resolved or abandoned his prayer due to passage of time or became infructuous.

5. Under the circumstances, no purpose would be sub-served in keeping the writ petition pending any further.
