The petitioner prays for disposal of the appeal filed before the Additional Chief Secretary, Health and Family Welfare Department on 18th November, 2022 in accordance with the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 read with the corresponding Rules of 1996.
3. Without going into the merit and maintainability of the appeal, the instant writ petition is disposed of by directing the Additional Chief Secretary, Health and Family Welfare Department to consider and dispose of the appeal annexed at
