representation dated 23.12.2023 which was furnished
with the Officer-in-charge, Hare Street Police Station

Police Station has submitted a report that the said
information furnished and forwarded by Hare Street
PS is not traceable at Nalhati PS. Accordingly, no
action has been taken either by the Hare Street PS or
the Nalhati PS.

In view of the same, Mr. Sen will send copy along with annexure to Nalhati PS who would assess whether any offence is made out or not and thereafter take steps in accordance with law
