When this matter was taken up for hearing, Mr. Roy, learned advocate for the opposite party raised various technical objections.

After some argument Mr. Bhattacharyya, learned Senior Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that there are some formal defects in the application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India. In view thereof, he prays for leave to withdraw this civil revision application with liberty to file afresh on the self-same cause of action as well as by challenging the subsequent orders passed in Title Appeal No. 2 of 2025.
