reflects that Falta Police Station Case No.90 of 2025
dated 11.04.2025 has been registered for
investigation and the police authorities have been
keeping a sharp vigil over the issue relating to
dispute.

Since the petitioner's primary grievance has
been addressed by the police authorities, I am of the
view that further pendency of the writ petition is
unwarranted.

Accordingly, WPA 8075 of 2025 is disposed of.

There will be no order as to costs.
