1. Affidavit of service filed in Court is taken on record.
2. In spite of service, none appears on behalf of the opposite party.
3. This revisional application has been filed assailing the order 15th March, 2023 passed in connection with Title Suit No.17 of 2023 whereby the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Haldia, Purba Medinipur, rejected an application under Order VII Rule 11 of the Code of Civil Procedure filed on behalf of the defendant/petitioner herein only on the ground that the application was not supported by any affidavit and verification.
4. Petitioner appearing in-person has tried to go into the merit of the suit which has not been considered by the learned Trial Court, at all.
5. After going through the order impugned, I do not find any infirmity to stand in the way, rather giving liberty to the defendant/petitioner herein to file a fresh
