Report submitted by the State reflects that on 07.05.2025, the victim girl was recovered under a proper recovery memo and the present petitioner being the father of the victim girl was informed regarding such recovery.

The regular Criminal Court is already *in seisin* of Dholahat P.S. Case No. 165 of 2025 dated 13.03.2025. Presumably, the Special Court should be *in seisin* of the instant criminal case.

Since the agony and anxiety of the present petitioner was for recovery of the victim girl who was not traceable and the initiation of the regular case did not

yield any result, the petitioner under such circumstanced approached this Court. The primary grievance of the petitioner being satisfied, I am of the view that further pendency of the writ petition is unwarranted.

Accordingly, WPA 8313 of 2025 is disposed of.
