In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Nandigram P.S. Case No.185/2025 dated 31.03.2025 under Sections 137(2)/140(3)/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023 pending before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Haldia.

Considering the exonerative statements of the victim recorded before the learned Magistrate and in view of the fact that the petitioners are not the principal accused, I do not think that custodial interrogation of the petitioners are required in this case.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, corresponding to Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and on further condition not to threaten or intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever and to cooperate with the investigation.

The application for anticipatory bail being **CRM (A) 1294 of 2025** is, thus, allowed.
