In spite of service, none appears on behalf
of the State-respondents.

The petitioner was an approved Librarian of
a library under the Department of Mass
Education Extension & Library Services, on
attaining the age of superannuation, she had
retired from her said service on February 28,
2021.

The Pension Payment Order of the
petitioner was issued on April 27, 2021, in
pursuance whereof, she had received the
gratuity and the arrear pension on August 11,
2021.

The petitioner is praying interest on the
arrear pension and gratuity for the delayed
payment.

The pension and gratuity have been paid to
the petitioner within a reasonable time after

retirement, therefore, the prayer of the petitioner for interest on the said pension and gratuity amount cannot be entertained.

W.P.A 8536 of 2025 stands disposed of with the above terms. There shall be no order as to costs.
