Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that there are disputes with some of the private respondents while with some of the private respondents, the petitioner has settled the dispute.

Since the petitioner is still facing inconveniences, under the changed circumstances, I direct the petitioner to submit a fresh representation with Inspector-in-Charge, Egra Police Station.

On receipt of such fresh representation, the concerned Inspector-in-Charge will conduct an enquiry and take steps in accordance with law.

With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition being WPA 9477 of 2024 is disposed of.

Pending connected application, if any, is consequently disposed of.

There will be no order as to costs.
