The petitioners seek parity with co-accused Pradip Jana who has been granted bail earlier.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer.

The petitioners appear to be similarly circumstanced with co-accused Pradip Jana who is on bail and deserve the same benefit.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail is allowed.

The petitioners namely Monoranjan Jana and Laxmi Jana be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Contai, subject to the condition that they shall appear before the learned trial Court on every date of hearing and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event the petitioners fail to comply with any of the conditions stated above without any justifiable cause, the learned trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel their bail in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

The application for bail is disposed of.
