I have perused the material on record. The petitioner
appears to be the principal assailant who shot at the victim
resulting in his death.

Considering the material on record connecting the
petitioner to the alleged crime, prayer for bail is **rejected**.

This Court is informed that the prosecution proposes to
examine 34 witnesses.

The learned Trial Court is directed to expedite the trial without granting any unnecessary adjournment to either of the parties.
